Objective

Set guidelines for Judging

Create judging criteria and forms

Judging Criteria

Each vehicle will be assigned a classification at registration and will be judged within that classification. Following are the classifications:

Chevrolet (all models, 1941 to present)

Ford (all models 1941 to present) Not including Mercury, Lincoln, etc.

MoPar (all vehicles 1941 to present) Not including Jeep

Other Domestic (Mercury, Lincoln, Jeep, Pontiac, Buick, Cadillac, etc 1941 to present)

Foreign (all makes and models 1941 to present)

Trucks (all makes and models 1941 to present)

Pre-War II (all makes and models prior to 1941)

Exotic (all makes and models, any year)

Street Rod (includes Rat Rods)

The classification will be prominently displayed on the registration card on the vehicle windshield. Should the entrant wish – the windshield card will note if the vehicle is **NOT TO BE JUDGED**.

Judges will assign point values for each judging category for each vehicle and a total point score will be assigned. The judges may add BONUS POINTS to the total score for exceptional display

Trophies will be presented as follows in each classification: 1st, 2nd, 3rd – based on total points. Ties will be broken by using the following category scores: Highest Bonus points, then Highest score for Paint & Body, then Engine, then Interior, then Over-all Display. If there is still a tie, the VCCA Judging Committee will determine the winner.

The BEST IN SHOW award will be the selected by the sponsor of the Best in Show trophy

Judging will take place at a time to be determined by the Club's Judging Committee.

Decision of the judges will be final and trophy presentation will take place in the order of: 3rd, 2nd, 1st, then Best of Show.
