CAR PHOTOGRAPHY

In the words of old-time car photographer, Ozzie Smith, "you can have nothing but great photos, as long as you throw away the bad ones". That seems to be my life. I have some really terrific photos as well as a thousand more really awful ones. But here are some tips to minimize the number of awful ones. First of all, know that cell phones are great at making phone calls, not so much as a camera. A digital camera will always produce a better photo then most cell phones.

1. **Lighting** - The best lighting is an hour before sunrise and an hour before sunset. The color is more subdued and the shadows are minimized. Also keep the sun to your back unless you have the sun blocked somehow while taking photos towards it.



2. Location - Find a location that either doesn't distract to the vehicle or enhances the look to the vehicle. People in the photo should be incidental to the vehicle and in the background.





3. **Perspective** - The most interesting perspective is called a ³/₄ view where you have the front and either the right or left side in the photo. Also taking the photo lower or higher from normal eye level makes for a more visual entertaining view. Cars are three dimensional objects and a flat side or front makes the most interesting vehicle boring. Save those photos for the car for sale folder.



4. **Close-up** - Sometimes a close-up of a portion of the vehicle or a detail of the vehicle makes for an interesting photo. Combined with a higher or lower perspective is also interesting.





5. Color or BW - Sometimes a BW photo makes a more dramatic presentation than if it were in color,

your eyes don't get distracted as much and you tend to focus on the entire picture.
